## Camp Philosophy:

The WVU pre-season hockey camp is intended to provide a safe, fun, skills based weekend experience to prepare players of all levels for the start of the hockey season. Players within each age group will be subdivided to facilitate appropriate training drills and optimal off ice education within a low instructor to player ratio.

## Age Groups

Level 1 (mite—beginner) / 9:00 a.m.—3:00 p.m.

- Players will be taught hockey fundamentals such as proper skating technique, balance, edge control, shooting, passing, puck control, and more.

Level 2 (squirt-peewee) / 10:30 a.m.—4:30 p.m.

- Program will reinforce skating technique and add speed to drills. Progressive drills will facilitate advanced skill development and work in game situations

Level 3 (bantam—midget—H.S.) / Noon—6:00 p.m.

- Players will build on fundamental skills and address body checking techniques, angling, body position, and puck protection.

Goaltenders (all ages)

- Goalies will be matched with appropriate age and skill levels and integrated into on ice sessions. Instruction / feedback will be provided.
